



Position Description: Minister in Residence at Jacob's Porch

Date for Position: August 1st 2024 - July 15th, 2025 (with option for longer and early move-in)

Location: 45 E 13th Ave. Columbus, OH 43201 (by The Ohio State University)

Compensation:

- Free Housing, Single Room Occupancy
- Includes free utilities, wifi
- Full Kitchen
- The hours are flexible and there are times off during Christmas and Spring breaks according to the Academic Calendar.

Summary:

The minister in residence position is an immersive opportunity to be a leader in a college ministry setting. Each year we hire 2 Minister's in Residence. You may interview with a friend who is also interested in the position. Jacob's Porch is an affirming religious community born out of the Lutheran tradition and currently has formal connections through staff with the United Methodist Church, Presbyterian Church (USA), and Mennonite Church. Our community is inclusive of many Christian faith traditions and works closely with faith leaders in the OSU community on interfaith dialogue and advocacy. This community values spiritual formation through the building of deeply humble, inquisitive and intentional relationships with others and God. As part of a larger staff team, the ministers in residence are at the heart of this work by providing hospitality, mentorship, and community building.

Responsibilities:

- The position is Part-time (Approximately 12-15 hours a week)
 - 8-10 hours of relational program/meeting time including Sunday evening worship gatherings and meals, one on one conversations with college students, participating in outreach events on campus and various programs in our building throughout the semester.
 - 4-6 hours cleaning, straightening and hospitality service for visitors
 - 2-3 weekend retreats per year (paid for)

- Most residents choose to work another part time or full-time job in addition to being a Ministry Resident.

-The minister in residence will work closely with the Pastoral team in meeting the needs of the students in our community. The Trustee Pastor will be the primary advisor over the position.

Qualifications:

- Ideally someone who has recently graduated from college or a graduate student.
- Has a desire for ongoing spiritual formation and for building a healthy community of young adults.
